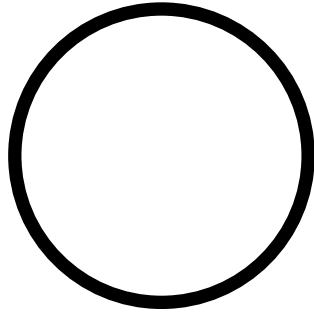


Red, yellow, and blue play dough*, Color Wheel template. *Optional:* Pencil.

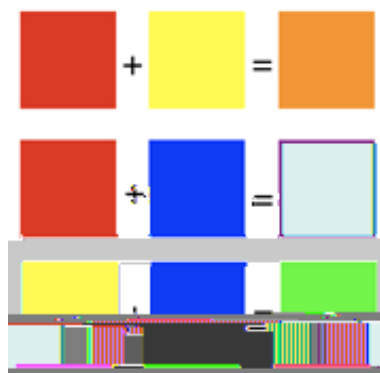

Start with a piece of dough from each of the primary colors (



Some materials let certain colors pass through them, and absorb other colors. These materials are called dyes or pigments. The colors of pigment are red, yellow, and blue. The primary colors can be mixed to create other colors.

A primary color + a primary color = a secondary color. The secondary colors are green, orange, and purple.
