MOTION:


The Faculty Senate moves to **AMEND THE 2010-11 CATALOG TO REFLECT** a two year placement test expiration and revise the following UA Faculty statement: 11-11-11

Placement heading on page 32, as indicated:

Effective: Fall 2010

Rationale: Placement test expiration periods are inconsistent across the UA system. Students attending different institutions within the system are confused by the differences. A common message is requested.

Furthermore, it is the hope of the SADA committee and the Developmental Math and Math faculty that this motion lead to Banner enforcement of prerequisites for math placement.

Students without appropriate standardized test scores (such as ACT, SAT, ASSET or ACCUPLACER), advanced placement credits, transfer credits or prerequisite coursework must have UAF-approved placement test scores prior to registering for classes their first semester at

PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE. Students may not enroll in classes unless they meet the placement requirements. Placement into appropriate developmental courses
